Tasting Notes

The fourth vintage of our traditional “left-bank” Bordeaux-style blend, the ‘03 “Cuvée” is 56% Cabernet Sauvignon, 28% Merlot, 10% Malbec and 6% Cabernet Franc, from a number of highly-regarded Columbia Valley vineyards. Cherry liquor, blueberry, dark chocolate and caramel aromas and flavors, soft tannins and a long smooth finish.
