



## **2004 Syrah Produced by JM Cellars Winemaker: John Bigelow**

### **Tasting Notes**

The 2004 Syrah is a wine that shows a deep core of dark fruit, traditional Hermitage aromas and flavors, and a finish of great length. As with the 2003 vintage, this wine shows complexity largely due to the blend of five great sites we sourced our syrah from in 2004.

### **Vineyards:**

Klipsun (Red Mountain)  
Milbrandt (Wahluke Slope)  
Stillwater Creek (Columbia Valley)  
Aldercreek (Horse Heaven Hills)  
Lewis (Yakima Valley)

### **Barrel Aging:**

Each lot barrel aged in Russian oak barrels (50% new and 50% once used) for 17 months

### **Blend:**

93% Syrah  
7% Cabernet Sauvignon (Red Mountain Vineyard)

**Alcohol:** 14.5%    **pH:** 3.85    **Total Acidity:** 0.55 g/100ml

**Case Production:** 292 cases
