**Tasting Notes**

Our second vintage of Viognier, from rising-star Stillwater Creek Vineyard on the Royal Slope in the Columbia Valley (blended with 6% Roussanne from the esteemed Ciel du Cheval Vineyard of Red Mountain). Styled after the wines of the famous Condrieu appellation in the Northern Rhône Valley. The huge nose of sweet peach and apricot jump from the glass, and the mouthfeel is viscous and rich - both of which belie the wine's crisp texture and bone dry finish.

**Vineyards:**

Stillwater Creek (Columbia Valley)

Ciel du Cheval (Red Mountain)

**Barrel Aging:**

Aged 'sur lie' in French oak barrels (50% new, 50% once used) for 2 months then transferred to neutral oak for 3 months and bottled

**Blend:**

94% Viognier

6% Roussanne

**Alcohol: pH: 3.31**

**Total Acidity: .66g/100ml**
